#### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE THE KING CITY COUNCIL

The City of King City Council will hold a public hearing on **Wednesday, September 20,** at **6:00 p.m.** in the King City - City Hall Council Chambers, 15300 S.W. 116<sup>th</sup> Avenue, King City, OR 97224, and Online via Zoom platform, regarding the following:

L.U. # 23-04, Community Development Code (Title 16, King City Municipal Code) Staff and consultants presenting on behalf of the City of King City, seek the adoption of a series of Community Development Code (CDC) amendments primarily to support the Kingston Terrace Master Plan, as well as changes and modifications to other Municipal Code and CDC amendments. These amendments are necessary to ensure development compliance with the Kingston Terrace Master Plan policies (O-2023-02), King City Comprehensive Plan amendments (O-2023-03), and King City Transportation System Plan policies (O-2023-01). In addition, other CDC and Municipal Code amendments address the state's Climate Friendly and Equitable Communities (CFEC) requirements, administration, annexations, signs, open fires, and overnight camping. The purpose of the hearing is to review the Planning Commission recommendation and consider public testimony. The code amendments will serve as a guide for future growth and development in King City and the Kingston Terrace Planning Area, which is bounded by the current city limit HWY 99 on the east, the Tualatin River on the south, Beef Bend Road on the north, and Roy Rogers Road on the west. If approved, it will be adopted as part of the King City Comprehensive Plan and Title 16, King City Municipal Code. The request will also be reviewed against the criteria of the Oregon Land Use Planning Goals, Oregon Revised Statues (particularly ORS 197 & 227), CFEC requirements (OAR 660, Divisions 8, 12, and 44), Metro's Urban Growth Management Functional Plan, Metro Regional Transportation Functional Plan, Regional Transportation Plan, King City Urban Planning Area Agreement, Metro Ordinance 18-1427, and the King City Comprehensive Plan.

All interested parties are invited to attend the hearing and express their views. Statements will be accepted in writing or orally at the hearing. Failure to raise an issue at the public hearing, in person or by letter, or failure to provide statements or evidence sufficient to afford the decision maker an opportunity to respond to the issue precludes appeal to the Land Use Board of Appeals based on that issue. The Planning Commission shall consider all information and testimony and make a recommendation to the King City Council.

The public may attend the hearing by coming to City Hall at the above address or joining the Zoom webinar. In accordance with <u>House Bill 2560</u>, this hybrid meeting enables people to join remotely or in-person to participate in the Planning Commission hearing and submit oral and/or written testimony in person or remotely. Zoom Links are on the reverse side of this Notice.
